## II. CALL TO ORDER:

The BAC Vice-Chairperson called the meeting to order at around 9:30am. After determining the existence of a quorum, the BAC Chairman proceeded to treat the official business of the day.

## III. MINUTES OF THE MEETING:

### III.A. OPENING OF BIDS

BAC Sec Staff informed the BAC that contract R8 22-02-0176 Supply and Delivery of Fiberglass Boat Accessories in support to Typhoon Odette Recovery and Rehabilitation Assistance to affected Fisherfolk in Region 8 has five (5) bidders namely: IZZO INDUSTRIAL SUPPLY, GRJV AGRI-INDUSTRIAL MACHINERIES, POLYMER PRODUCTS (PHIL) INC., SUKI TRADING CORPORATION and TACLOBAN GRACE TRADING. Also, for contract R8 22-02-0168 Labor and Materials for the Repair & Improvement of PFO-UEP Facilities at N. Samar has two (2) bidders namely: RM CHIA CONSTRUCTION AND SUPPLY and GRINDER CIVIL ENGINEERING CONSTRUCTION. Remaining contract R8 22-03-0211 Supply and Delivery of Training Materials for Boat Repair in the Municipality of Limasawa So. Leyte in response to Typhoon Odette has no bids receive during opening so the Presiding Officer instructed the BAC Sec to repost it in the Philgeps website as soon as possible.

After the BAC Vice-Chairman acknowledged the participants for today's meeting, she instructed the BAC Sec Staff to proceed to the opening of the first contract for R8 22-02-0176 Supply and Delivery of Fiberglass Boat Accessories in support to Typhoon Odette Recovery and Rehabilitation Assistance to affected Fisherfolk in Region 8 by showing to the screen the original Technical, Legal and Financial Components of the first bidder IZZO INDUSTRIAL SUPPLY. The remaining copies of the documents marked as "Copy 1 & 2" were examined by the TWG. The same procedure was done to the remaining four (4) bidders namely GRJV AGRI-INDUSTRIAL MACHINERIES, POLYMER PRODUCTS (PHIL) INC., SUKI TRADING CORPORATION and TACLOBAN GRACE TRADING. All five bidders were rated PASSED and proceeded to the opening of the Financial Bid Components.

After the examination and evaluation, the BAC declares TACLOBAN GRACE TRADING as the Lowest Calculated Bid and recommended for the Post- Qualification of the BAC-TWG.

Thereafter, the Presiding Officer instructed the BAC Sec Staff to proceed to the opening of the second contract, R8 22-02-0168 Labor and Materials for the Repair & Improvement of PFO-UEP Facilities at N. Samar by showing on screen the original Technical, Legal and Financial Components of the first bidder RM CHIA CONSTRUCTION AND SUPPLY. Upon examination and evaluation, the BAC

found out that the aforementioned bidder did not meet the required equipment needed for the contract for it lacks (1) concrete mixer bagger, so the BAC declared that the bid of RM CHIA CONSTRUCTION AND SUPPLY as FAILED. The BAC Vice-Chair instructed the BAC Sec Staff to inform the aforementioned bidder regarding the result of their bid. On that same day, the BAC Sec staff conveyed the result of the opening of bids by calling and texting the bidder's representative and also added that if they wish to contest the decision of the BAC, they are entitled to file a Motion for Reconsideration (MR) within three (3) days upon receipt of written notice or verbal notification.

Furthermore, the BAC Vice-Chair instructed the BAC Sec Staff to proceed to the opening of the envelope containing the original technical, legal and financial components of GRINDER CIVIL ENGINEERING CONSTRUCTION by flashing it to the screen. The remaining copies of the documents marked as "Copy 1 & 2" were examined by the TWG. Following due diligence of the first envelope, The BAC found that GRINDER CIVIL ENGINEERING CONSTRUCTION complied with the documents required for the submission of eligibility and technical requirement and were rated "PASSED". Immediately after, the financial bid envelope was opened. After careful examination, the BAC declares GRINDER CIVIL ENGINEERING CONSTRUCTION as the Lowest Calculated Bid and recommended for the Post- Qualification of the BAC -TWG.

Moreover, the BAC Vice- Chairman instructed the BAC Sec Staff to proceed to the next agenda for the day.

### **III.B. NEGOTIATED CONFERENCE**

The proceedings started with the examination of the envelope containing the bid documents submitted by the lone bidder PACIFICA AGRIVET SUPPLIES INC. for the contract R8 22-01-0004 Supply and Delivery of Various Feeds for the Implementation of BFAR 8 Projects in the Region. The BAC Vice-Chair instructed the BAC Sec Staff to open the original Technical, Legal and Financial Components by showing it to the screen.

After careful examination and evaluation, the BAC declares PACIFICA AGRIVET SUPPLIES INC. as the Lowest Calculated Bid and recommended to advance for the Post-Qualification of the BAC-TWG.

### **III. C. PRE-BID CONFERENCE**

The BAC Chairman asked BAC Secretariat staff to show on screen the Philippine Bidding Document of the project and briefly went over the salient features thereof such as the following: a) approved budget of the contract (ABC); b) delivery schedule; c) payment scheme/schedule; d) technical specifications.

The first contract showed on screen was *R8 22-03-0271 Supply and Delivery of Tilapia Feeds for the Implementation of Tilapia Culture Projects in support to ELCAC EO70 in the Region* with an ABC of Php 1,017,590.00 followed by the contract *R8 22-03-0241 Labor and Materials for the Repair of PFO Office Roof & Ceiling & Construction of PFO Storage Building at Brgy. Cumbado Maasin, So. Leyte* with an ABC of Php 950,000.00 and lastly, the contract *R8 22-03-0242 Labor and Materials for the Repair/Rehabilitation of Sogod Tilapia Satellite Hatchery at Sogod, So. Leyte* with an ABC of Php 900,000.00.

There being no changes made to the abovementioned contract, the BAC Vice-Chair declared that the opening for this contract will be pushed through. Interested bidders may coordinate the BAC Secretariat for further queries.

### **III. D. OTHER MATTERS**



### **IV. ADJOURNMENT:**


Having no more matters/issues to be discussed, the BAC Vice-Chairman declares adjournment of the meeting at around 1:31 pm.
