#### III.A. OPENING OF BIDS

The BAC Chairman informed the BAC secretariat staff to start the opening of bids with contract that has a large number of bid proposals received to be followed by contract with lone/sole bidder. Supply Canal Dike Riprap with an approved budget of the contract (ABC) of Php 2,000,000.00 has six (6) bid proposals received as shown in the table below;

Bidders H.A.H REVERIE CONSTRUCTION and PLGL CONSTRUCTION signified their interest to file an MR.

After which, the BAC secretariat staff proceeded to the opening of the contract ITB No: 2023-0001 Supply and Delivery of Bangus Fry to be use for the Garungan and Fingerlings Production of BFAR 8 with an approved budget of the contract (ABC)of L1: 5,560,000; L2:208,000; L3: 364,000 TOTAL: Php 6,132,000.00 whereby two (2) bidders submitted their bid as shown in the table below;

Furthermore, the BAC Chairperson instructed the BAC secretariat staff to proceed to the opening of the contract ITB No: 2023-0002 Fabrication, Installation and Delivery of HDPE Cages with Mooring System under the SAAD and Cages for Livelihood Project in Region 8 with an approved budget of the contract (ABC) of L1: 13,300,000; L2: 3,500,000 TOTAL: 16,800,000.00. The said contract received a lone bidder namely INCA PHILS. INC. for all the lots.
